11.2 Rules	New Zealand Fire Commission and Wellington Rural Fire Authority	S142/018	Not stated	Add new rule for the Wairarapa Coast Whaitua chapter: <u>Rule RXXX: Take and use of water for Firefighter Training - permitted activity</u> The take and use of water for firefighter training purposes is a permitted activity provided the following conditions are met: (a) Each water take shall not occur for longer than 2 hours within a 24 hour period, and (b) Surface water bodies shall only be utilised where there is a rate of flow that exceeds the rate of take from the water body, and (c) The water is not taken from a natural wetland, or from within 50m of a natural wetland, and (d) Fish are prevented from entering the intake.
